The letter grades and the corresponding grade points are as shown below:

G_i = is the Grade points corresponding to the grade awarded for the course. $i = 1, 2, \dots, n$ represent the number of courses in which a student is registered in the concerned semester. The SGPA is rounded off to two decimal places. The Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) will be computed at the end of each Semester as per the following formula:

REGULATION FOR THE POST GRADUATE EXAMINATIONS

1. The Marksheet / Grade Card of a student shall reflect overall performances in all papers in the concerned Semester. The aggregate of each paper shall be calculated as a sum of the marks obtained in Internal Assessment (20% of the total marks) and the marks obtained in Semester End Examination (80% of the total marks).
2. A student shall have to qualify in all the Semesters for the awarding of the degree. The qualifying marks for each theory paper shall be 40% and in the aggregate it shall be 40% of the total marks in each Semester.
3. A student who secures 40% in aggregate in a Semester but scores less than 40% in not more than two papers (Theory / Practical/ Project) will be considered as Supplementary Candidate [Result as 'XS'] but the candidate will be provisionally promoted to the next Semester.
4. If a candidate scores less than 40% in more than two papers, then the candidate will be declared as 'Not Promoted' to the higher Semester.
5. Candidate should clear the Supplementary papers/ back papers in next two chances. The qualifying marks shall be 40% in each paper.
6. A candidate who does not secure 40% in aggregate in a Semester, will also be declared as 'Not Promoted' to the higher Semester.
7. If a candidate is not able to clear supplementary papers in two (02) consecutive chances, the candidate will be declared as 'Failed' [Result as 'X'].
8. A student may have a maximum of four (04) Supplementary/back papers within the tenure. More than four (04) Supplementary/ back papers shall lead to the termination of promotion to the higher Semesters.
9. A student is allowed with a maximum of four (04) consecutive years to complete the Two (02) year Post-Graduate Programmes of the University.

12. Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)

CGPA = $\left[\frac{\sum_{j=1}^4 (SGPA_j \times D_j)}{\sum_{j=1}^4 D_j} \right]$ where $SGPA_j$ = SGPA of the j-th Semester, $D_j = \sum_{i=1}^n C_i$ = total credit of j-th Semester, C_i = the credit of the i-th paper in the j-th Semester and $j = 1$ to 4; n = number of papers in the j-th Semester.

13. Re-examination

Re-examination of only two papers (Theory Course) per Semester shall be allowed for the candidates appearing at Semester End Examination as a whole provided the candidate has secured at least 40% marks in the remaining papers of the concerned Semester End Examination.

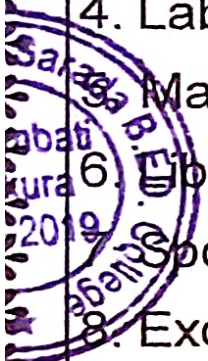
